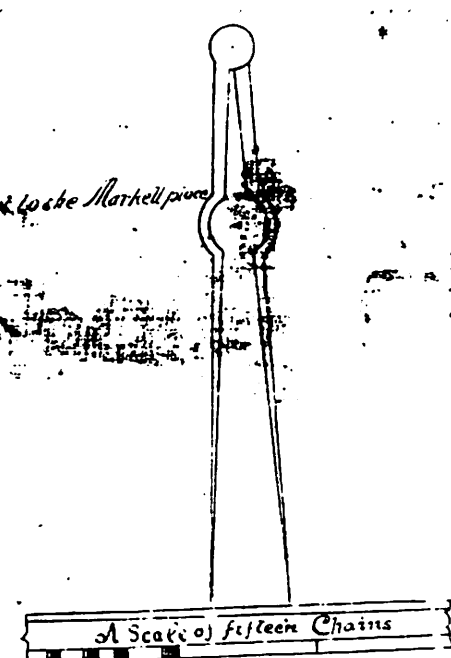




Cooper River



By virtue of a warrant under the hand and Seale of the hono: James Colleton, Esq: Lieutenant Governour bearing date the 15th day November Anno Domini 1688 - I have measured & laid out unto Thomas Smith Esq: all that quantity of land in Charlestowne, being Six acres & commonly knowne by the name of Oyster poyn^t poyn^t which s^d poyn^t of land is an outport of Charlestowne and butting to the Southward upon Ashely river and to the Northward upon the lot of Robert Collins and bounding to the Eastward upon Cooper River and to the Westward upon the implead lot of Mrs Mary Benson deceased which the above delineated plat doth represent the true forme and shape thereof together wth the true sittings boundings and Markes as in the grand modell of the said towne now remaining in the Surveyor generalls Office more at large appeares performed this present 12 day of November Anno Dom 1688
