Mr. James J. Saffitte, Widower of Savannah aged
fifty four years being duly sworn saith
That she was well well acquainted
with Mrs. John Fox, Mrs. Cahill afterward
Mrs. Woodward and Mrs. Henrietta Belmore
who were always called and known as
the children of Henry Boughman the Elder
she always understood that Mrs. Morel
and Mrs. Boughman were also daughters
of the said Henry, but these persons this
deponent clearly say she recollects that
they have descended, living - That Mrs.
Boughman had three children one named
David one named Polly and the other named
she does not recollect - She cannot
state what family Mrs. Morel had - Mr.
Fox had two children David who died
before her and John who died after her
Mrs. Cahill had by Mr. Cahill three sons
and a daughter Henry, John Lewis
and Polly - Polly married Mr. McRitch
who lived on May River in South Carolina
and had by him, so far as deponent knows
to wit Henry McRitch, John McRitch and

Mrs Scott the wife of Joseph Adam Scott - Mr David Augusinus the son of the aforesaid daughter of the said Henry Bouguerin moved to Carolina; she cannot say when he died or what children he left.

And the deponent further that she - knew Henry Bouguerin, Benedict Bouguerin, David Francis Bouguerin ~~and also his son~~ and Papot (who was the mother of deponent) Mrs Mary White and Mrs Mary Ann de Knight - These were the children of Benedict Bouguerin the elder who was full deponent always understood from her family, the Brother of Henry Bouguerin the elder - There was also John Bouguerin and Mr Fordale who died before deponent's recollection - all the aforesaid children of Benedict Bouguerin the elder are dead -

This deponent says that it was always said in the family and such was the common report that that Henry and Benedict Bouguerin the elder married a mother and her daughter named Shotley who came from Switzerland - Henry married the mother and Benedict the daughter and by these persons they had the children aforesaid -

That Mr. Billy McRish the Father of
John and Henry McRish died some
few years ago certainly within
ten years -

That Mrs. Mary Ann McNight died
some years ago, not twenty years but
near it, in Chatham County - leaving
no childress at her death but four
grand children to wit Mrs. Mary Eller
widow of Geo. Waller who has one
child, Isaac Young, Benedict Young
and Ann who married first Mr.
Collins and afterward Jesse Sanderson.

That Mrs. Calie afterwards married ~~John~~
Wadding by whom she had two
sons and a daughter, Jack Wadding
who died leaving two sons now living
George and Jacob, Bartolome Wadding
who died leaving one child, Ann
the present wife of Mr. Anthony Bar-
clay - and Mrs. Henrietta S. Albany -
