Mrs Jane S. Luffitte, widow of Samannak aged
fifty four years being duly sworn saith
that she was well well acquainted
with Mrs John Fox, Mrs Cahil afterwards
Mrs Wadbury and Mrs Henrietta Jones
who were always called and known as
the children of Henry Bouquien the father
she always understood that Mrs Morel
and Mrs Bouquien were also daughters
of the said Henry, but these persons this
deponent cannot say she recollects that
they have descendants living - That Mrs
Bouquien had three children, one named
David one named Polly and the other names
she does not recollect - She cannot
state what family Mrs Morel had - Mrs
Fox had two children David who died
before her and John who died after her
Mrs Cahil had by W. Cahil three sons
and a daughter, Henry, John Lewis
and Polly - Polly married W. McRish
who lived on May River in South Carolina
and had by him, so far as deponent knows
to wit Henry McRish, John McRish and

Mrs Scott the wife of Joseph Adam
Scott. Mr David Benjamin the
son of the deceased daughter of the
said Henry Benjamin moved to
Carolina; she cannot say when he
died or what children he left.

And the deponent saith that she
knew Henry Benjamin, Benedict Benjamin
David Francis Benjamin, Mr. Benjamin
Papet (who was the mother of deponent)
Mr. Mary White and Mr. Mary Ann
de Knight. These were the children
of Benedict Benjamin the elder who
was said deponent always understood
from his family, the Brother of Henry
Benjamin the elder. There was also
John Benjamin and Mr. Jordale who
died before deponent recalled him -
All the deceased children of Benedict
Benjamin the elder are dead.

The deponent says that it was always
said in the family and such was
the common reputation that Henry
and Benedict Benjamin the elder
married a mother and her daughter
named Shobley who came from
Switzerland. Henry married the
mother and Benedict the daughter
and by these persons they had the chil-
dren aforesaid.

That Mr. Polly Mc Nish the mother of
John and Henry Mc Nish died some
few years ago certainly within
ten years -

That Mrs. Mary Ann Mc Knight died
some years ago, not twenty years but
near it, in Chatham County leaving
no children at her death but four
grand children to wit Mrs. Mary Ellen
widow of Geo. Wallen, who has one
child, Isaac Young, Benedict Young
and Ann who married first Mr.
Collin and afterwards Jesse Sandelin

That Mrs. Cahill afterwards married Mr.
Waldberg by whom she had two
sons and a daughter, Jacob Waldberg
who died leaving two sons now living
George and Jacob, Parloene Waldberg
who died leaving one child, Ann
the present wife of Mr. Anthony Bar-
clay - and Mrs. Henrietta G. Albany -
