I'll trouble you again. I value your ideas. You are correct about the coat-of-arms of Albermarle. I've written the State - hope I can use ^{the} picture to illustrate.

Can you add to this trial chart before I type to send to a record researcher?

So many clues point to TS here 1670 leaving his wife and young sons in England?

1. Neither child born Carolina
2. Barbara did not come until 1683
3. Early maps locate James and Thomas on East side Ashley, about where Thomas later sold "half way house."
4. The Thomas and James land on west side of Ashley went to Benj Pierpont, early Pres. minister.
5. The Gov. never got his bounty land, possibly because officials claimed he was not due land. His son did get it.
6. Mr Stony believed he was associated with Madagascari in some way.

One genealogist living in Exter wants \$2.40 per hour plus expenses - She suggests she start with Orig Parish registers in Record office Somerset in Taunton. (I feel that's been done.)

However the Archivist in Taunton

on his own checked the Parish register and sent me the same records found by Mrs Wade. He says the birth registers for TS's period have not survived. He also checked Marriage Register for TS and found none.

I'll be glad to follow up if you have suggestions, as I stand now I can only suggest that he may be of the same family etc.

My idea is to send chart to a specialist in royalty and nobility. Any one familiar with British Library could check it out in a short time. I've tried "Debrett Ancestry Research" and had no answer.
