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FOREWORD

On November 30, 1706, the Assembly of South Carolina passed an act to establish the Church of England in the province. By this act each parish was to provide "a fit person for a register" who was to "make true entry of all vestry proceedings, and of all births, christenings, marriages and burials, (negroes, mollatoes and Indian slaves excepted,) that is to say, the christian and sir-name with the day and month and year of every such births, christenings, marriages and burials. . . ." The churchwardens of each parish were to "provide good and substantial writing books, well bound, sufficient for registering such proceedings" and making such entries. Thus each parish was to keep two sets of records: the minutes of the vestry and the register of births, christenings, marriages, and burials.

The originals of these records for the parish of St. Philip's, which have recently been laminated and rebound, are preserved in the office of the church in Charleston. The vestry minutes which are still extant begin in 1732. The eighteenth-century records of vital statistics were printed in two volumes: in 1904 A. S. Salley, Jr., edited the *Register of St. Philip's Parish, Charles Town, South Carolina, 1720-1758*, which was printed by Walker, Evans & Cogswell Co. of Charleston; in 1927 D. E. Huger Smith and A. S. Salley, Jr., edited the *Register of St. Philip's Parish, Charles Town, or Charleston, S. C. 1754-1810*, which was published by the South Carolina Society, Colonial Dames of America, and printed in Charleston. The vestry of St. Philip's Church has now made arrangements with the University of South Carolina Press to republish these two volumes, which have long been out of print, as a contribution to the South Carolina Tricentennial celebration. This is a

wise decision for these volumes are valuable to both the genealogist and the historian.

There are similar records for the nine other Anglican parishes established in 1706 and for the eighteenth-century dissenting congregations, but, although some are older, none are more important than these since the parish of St. Philip's included the entire town of Charleston until the town was divided in 1751 by the creation of the parish of St. Michael's. St. Michael's, however, did not function as a parish until February 1, 1761, when Robert Cooper, the first rector of the parish, held divine service in the new building for the first time. Therefore, these are the vital statistics for the most important center in the early history of South Carolina.

It would be difficult to estimate the number of persons who are descended from those whose births, baptisms, marriages, and burials are recorded in these records, but they are legion and are spread over the United States today. These volumes should, therefore, be in every library in the United States that has a genealogical section.

Historians have continually used these records to solve a number of historical problems. The date of marriage may provide the earliest evidence of the presence of an individual in the province. The record of children born over a period of years to a couple can be used as evidence that that couple was continuously resident in the province during that span of years. The only official record of the presence of a Jamaican visitor to the province is the entry in these records of a burial notice.

The demographers, a new breed of historians, will find partial answers to many questions among these statistics. At what average age did men and women marry and die in South Carolina? Were there any seasonal variations in births and deaths? Perhaps the reprinting of these volumes will provide the occasion for some eager young historian to attempt to answer these and other questions in the field of demography. Already a great deal of work has been done by analyzing the church records of New England.

In 1897 Edward McCrady, then senior warden of the parish, wrote a short history of the church which was published under the title: *An Historic Church. The Westminster Abbey of South Carolina. A Sketch*

of St. Philip's Church, Charleston, S. C., From the Establishment of the Church of England under the Royal Charter of 1665 to the Present Time (July, 1897). A new history is now needed to place beside the volume of George W. Williams on St. Michael's Church. The reprinting of these records should be prelude to a thorough study of both the history and the architecture of what McCrady called "the old church."

Salley faithfully followed the form of the original register. A spot check confirms the accuracy of the transcription. The user of this volume should be cautioned that there are two indexes and two sets of pagination. The manuscript index is printed at the beginning of this volume and the numbers there refer to the manuscript page numbers which Salley placed in brackets in the printed text. Salley's index is at the rear, and the page numbers there refer to the pagination of the printed volume.

One further explanation may help the user. The original registrar had divided his large bound volume into four equal portions for the recording of births, baptisms, marriages, and burials. But when the section set aside for the recording of burials had been filled, the registrar entered the later burials in the section of the volume reserved for marriages. When the section for marriages had also been filled, the registrar used the remaining portion of the section reserved for baptisms. Thus in the original and in this volume the burials for 1744-1753 precede those for 1720-1743; also the marriages for 1753-1755 precede those for 1720-1753. The user of the volume will, therefore, find in succession the record of births from 1718 to 1758, of christenings from 1720 to 1758, of marriages from 1753 to 1755 followed by those from 1720 to 1753, and of burials from 1744 to 1753 followed by those from 1720 to 1743.

PREFACE.

In 1719 the General Assembly of South Carolina directed that a parish register be kept in each parish in the Province. The register of St. Philip's Parish starts with the year 1720, but a few records of earlier dates were entered subsequently. St. Philip's Parish dates from 1682, but it is not now known whether any sort of register was kept prior to 1720.

This copy of the register of St. Philip's Parish was made by me from the original. The letters and figures in brackets indented into the printing show the pagination of the original. The index to the original is arranged in double column, but here the large letters represent the beginning of each page and the small letters the beginning of the second column of each page.
