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FOREWORD

The user of this volume should know that the index found in the front of the manuscript volume was not printed by D. E. Huger Smith and A. S. Salley, Jr. The editors did indicate the pagination of the manuscript volume, but the printed index refers to the pagination of the printed volume.

The manuscript volume has recently been laminated and rebound as two volumes: "Births and Baptisms, 1753-1810" and "Marriages and Burials, 1753-1810."

"Births and Baptisms, 1753-1810" contains the record of births from September 20, 1754, to March 8, 1774, and of baptisms from December 19, 1756, to August 10, 1810. The baptisms appear in the following order both in the manuscript and in the printed volumes: May 6, 1796, to December 28, 1802; March 16, 1796, to August 10, 1810; December 19, 1756, to November 17, 1782; and then, after a gap of over four years, from January 1, 1787, to October 10, 1801. The haphazard arrangement is due to the fact that later baptisms were recorded in the portion of the volume reserved for the entry of births after it was apparent that the record of births would occupy comparatively few pages.

"Marriages and Burials, 1753-1810" contains the records of marriages from June 28, 1755, to November 1, 1774; July 1, 1781, to August 18, 1782; November 14, 1774, to February 22, 1780; and then, after a blank of almost seven years, from January 14, 1787, to October 8, 1801; and April 27, 1796, to December 29, 1802. The records of burials cover the periods from November 19, 1753, to August 7, 1770; October 29, 1779, to November 12, 1782; and, after a blank of almost fourteen years, from August 24, 1796, to May 22, 1803.

The date 1810 is somewhat misleading as attached to the title of this volume. There are two other bound volumes in the church office with burial records prior to 1810. "Burials and Baptisms, 1796-1809" contains records of burials from May 26, 1803, to October 25, 1809, which were not transferred to the large volume for the years 1753-1810. "Burials, 1805-1853" has records of burials from 1805 to 1853 and, therefore, many entries prior to 1810. The editors may have omitted these not only because they had not been trans-

ferred to the larger volume, but also because they have more than a simple notation of burial. In "Burials and Baptisms, 1796-1809" the notation contains the following information: "Name, Age, Place of Nativity, Disease, Member or Stranger, Minister, Service." In "Burials, 1805-1853": "Date, Name, Age, Occupation or Profession, Place of Nativity, Disease or Casualty, Time of Residence, Member." Such entries are a storehouse of valuable information. The entry for the burial of Christopher Gadsden reads: "1805, Aug. 29, Christopher Gadsden, 81 yr. 6 mo., General, Charleston, Parliotic Stroke, 71 ys., Member." The user is, therefore, warned that though the final date is 1810 in the title some of the parish records for burials before 1810 still exist in manuscript form in the church office.

To rearrange all of the records in simple chronological order would have been to undertake an entirely new project. The decision has been made merely to reprint this volume in the exact form in which it first appeared. In that way those sponsoring the reprinting have been faithful to the original manuscripts. The index will help the searchers to bypass this problem of organization without any trouble.
