

Information on Laddon & Stanyarne came from Charleston County
Library the evening of May 31, 2005, in downtown Charleston, SC.

STANYARNE

Thomas Stanyarne (great-great-great-great-great grandfather of John Bell) had grants of land in the Province of South Carolina as early as 1675. We quote from "Warrants for Lands 1672-1679," by A. S. Salley, p. 122:

"Carolina: You are forthwith to cause to be admeasured and layd out for Thomas Stanyan 950 acres of land for himself, his wife, five children and four servants arriving in May 1675."

Also we find: "You are forthwith to admeasure and lay out for Mr. Thos. Stanjon one of the freemen of this Province 450 acres of land in some place not yet laid out or marked to be laid for any other Person or use," etc. etc.

"Given under our hands at Charles Towne
ye 31st of March 1677 - To - Capt. Maurice
Mathews, Surveyor"

"Lords Proprietors etc., grant Thomas Stanyarne a plantation containing 900 acres of land English measure on Western branch of Wandoe River and boundary as per platte - 14 July 1677 - (950 A. Christ Church Parish) Entered 7 May 1678."

Will of Thomas Stanyarne

May 10, 1682

I, Thomas Stanyarne of Charles Towne, merchant, make this my last will being weak in body. Ap. my beloved wife executrix with son James Stanyarne this house and plantation I now (live) upon Charles Towne Neck. One-half my cattle, hogs, household stuff, etc. to my wife Mary Stanyarne for life. To my eldest son James Stanyarne sd. dwelling etc., the other half equally between my 5 children, James Stanyarne, John Stanyarne, Thomas Stanyarne, William Stanyarne and Mary Ladson, land on Wandoe which I took up for my rights, 1050 acres to be sold to pay debt I owe to Peleg Withington and overplus between my 4 sons. Land on the S. W. side of Stono River which I bought of Peleg Withington, 400 equally divided between my 4 sons. I give jointly to my son James and his Mother my mare which I used to ride on. To Assembly of people called Quakers in Province of Carolina one heifer calf, etc. to Jonathan Fitch, John Ladson and Edward Maye for support of such poor friends as be living among them, etc. To Mary Everit the second heifer and Exor's to make inventory without oath.
