STUMP, 86, of Bluffton, died April 20. She was a lifelong outspoken advocate for social justice who came to Hardeeville in 1997 to serve a booming Hispanic population for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Charleston. She and the late Sister Mary Gallagher, of the Religious Sisters of Mercy, founded the Mercy Ministries of the Lowcountry Thrift Store and food pantry in Hardeeville. She also worked to provide affordable housing in Hardeeville and helped the courts, police and schools as a translator and liaison to the Hispanic community. She was honored as grand marshal of the Hardeeville Christmas Parade in 2012.
