Having shown your article which appeared in the Island Packet, 8/12/1976 to some of my distant Talbird relatives in Beaufort, SC, they advised that you were the foremost authority regarding the Talbird family. It is my understanding that Henry Talbot, the progenitor of the Talbird family in this country, had two wives; Mary Hannon with whom he had at least three children, Richard (1762-1779) killed in war, Henry (?) married Margaret Eliza? and John (1760-1825) married Mary Ann Ladson; and the other wife Mary Doharty with whom he had at least four children, Mary (1746-1827) married Dr. John Rhodes, Thomas (1755-1803) married Christiana Crawford, William (1753-1756) and Ann (1758-?) married (? Bush).

Any information which you would be willing to share with me which would either confirm, add to, or correct my understanding would be greatly appreciated.
