





RESEARCH NOTES:

The records of the births of Barnabas TAYLOR (#8) (b: circa 1783) and his brother James TAYLOR (#11) (b: circa 1789) have eluded professional genealogical researchers in Salt Lake City's world famous "Family History Library," the archives of Lincolnshire in Lincoln, as well as the wonderful record collection housed in the 'Castle' at Nottingham, England.

Their brother, George TAYLOR (#10) (my direct ancestor) was born 22 November 1778 in the village of Habrough, Lincolnshire. But George's brothers (Barnabas and James) are not found in the parish records of that village. Why not? Sloppy record keeping by the local vicar? Or maybe they had disassociated themselves from the Church of England therefore no record in the local parish. Or: birth took place at the home of a friend/relative in another town? Or: The family moved to Nottingham after George's birth in 1778 and before Barnabas was born in 1783? (By 1827 the family was living in Nottingham.)

There is plenty of evidence to confirm George and Barnabas were brothers but until recently nothing but circumstantial evidence to link James as a brother has been available.

I believe the following is all the proof I need to include and confirm James as a brother to George and Barnabas..

EVIDENCE: 13 April 1862 Mary TAYLOR (Richmond, Virginia) wrote in her diary about her "cousin" Edward P. Taylor (#20) when he visits the Richmond, Virginia, Taylor family during the Civil War. She was a great granddaughter of George TAYLOR (#10). Ref: Baptist Historical Society at University of Richmond. This diary entry connects her line to James Taylor line.

This remark places James as a brother of Barnabas!

EVIDENCE: James TAYLOR (#11) had a granddaughter named Sarah Alice TAYLOR. She is identified as related to the Brantly family (her Mom was Lily Ora BRANTLY) and related to the well known divine Rev. George Boardman TAYLOR (#29) (one of the sons of James Barnett TAYLOR). See "Sketches of Prominent Tennesseans" page 190 published 1888 (found in public library in Nashville, Tennessee). This item establishes direct relationship between descendants of James TAYLOR and George Boardman TAYLOR lines

EVIDENCE: After finding children, grandchildren, and even great grandchildren of the three brothers researchers have found many names shared in the three lines, i.e. Caroline, George, James and Craddock. Also trades/vocations were also found to be the same or closely related.

FURTHER EVIDENCE that the Taylors of Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire, England, intermingled after their arrival in America: George Braxton Taylor (#51) was the pastor of the First Baptist Church in Macon, GA, November 1891 (Salary \$2,500.00 per year). Although his parents were from Richmond, VA, George accepted the job in Macon. It was also in Macon that his son, George Cabell Taylor (#69) was born 31 Oct. 1893. (Ref: "Special Collections Library" Mercer University, Macon, GA, 31207) also Ref: Abridged Compendium of American Genealogy 1925 Edition. We do know that James Taylor (#11) left Savannah, GA, and made his home in Macon, GA, and most of his family became permanent residents in Macon as evidenced by their final resting place in the family plot in Rose Hill Cemetery, Macon, GA. Pastor George Braxton Taylor (#51), however, left Macon to return to Richmond, VA, where many of his family lie in rest at Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond, VA.

IMMIGRANT HISTORY OF LINCOLNSHIRE TAYLORS TO AMERICA

James Barnett Taylor (#14) was the infant son of George Taylor (#10) and his wife Christiana Barnett. James was born in Barton-upon-Humber, England, 19 March 1804 although his parents had been lifelong residents of Habrough and Wootton, Lincolnshire, towns several kilometers south and east of Barton. Times were tough in those days as England was at war with France. George, a skilled carpenter, was unable to make a good living in northern Lincolnshire so the family decided to emigrate to America. After a few days at sea their ship was accosted by a British Man-of-War and all young men of fighting Lincolnshire so the family decided to emigrate to America. After a few days at sea their ship was accosted by a British Man-of-War and all young men of fighting age were impressed into the service of the crown. During the transfer from their ship Christiana fell overboard and, luckily, was quickly rescued. But the plight of the young mother with her infant was too much for the Naval officers and the next day they were replaced on their original ship headed towards the new world. Arriving in New York City, George quickly found work as a carpenter making coffins for the dead as a Yellow Fever epidemic ravaged the populace. The family later settled in Richmond, Virginia, and now rest in Hollywood Cemetery there. (Ref. "Life and Times of James B. Taylor" published in 1872 by the Bible and Publication Society (Philadelphia) authored by George B. Taylor (#14) was larger to the larger of pricing this effect we have been upoble to determine the date larger.

The uncle of James Barnett Taylor (#14) was James Taylor (#11). At the time of printing this chart we have been unable to determine the date James Taylor (#11) left England nor have we determined why he selected Savannah, GA, as his first home in America.




"Dr. (John P.) Blankenship was married the second time at Macon, Georgia, November 4, 1885 to Miss Alice S. (Sarah) Taylor, daughter of Charles Taylor, Esq., at his residence. The Taylor family are related to the Brantly family of Georgia and North Carolina; and also to Rev. George Taylor, a noted Baptist divine of Richmond, Virginia, now missionary at Rome, Italy (for the Baptist Church). Mrs. Alice S. (Sarah) Blankenship is a member of the Episcopal church."

RESEARCH FINDINGS: The above excerpt* helps confirm the findings of researchers that the Taylor family of Macon, GA were related to (and presumably knew well) my ancestors from Richmond, VA – Richard B. Taylor, Las Vegas *(Page 192 "Prominent Tennesseans" published Nashville, TN, 1888).

"Sunday, April 13th. My scholars said a large number of verses (and I) gave out 84 tickets . . . Dr. Jeter and Cousin Ed Taylor (Edward P. Taylor) of the 8th Georgia (8th Georgia Guard C.S.A. Macon, GA) dined with us. Cousin Ed left with Paa (Dad) for camp in the afternoon, but met his (military) company with two brigades marching down the street enroute for Yorktown . . . sudden orders had been given . . . after (church meeting) I returned (home and) could not but think . . . of the soldiers who . . . might soon be lying cold and lifeless on a bloody field, their souls in eternity."

RESEARCH FINDINGS: Additional confirmation that my ancestors were related to the Taylors of Macon, GA was found in "The diary of Mary Taylor 1860-1864" published by the Virginia Baptist Historical Society (at the University of Richmond) (page 928 <u>The Virginia Baptist Register</u>)

Pictured above is the village church where our ancestor JOHN TAYLOR was sealed in marriage to ELIZABETH SMITH on the 19 of February 1720/21. Their first child: GEORGE TAYLOR was christened there the 26th of December 1721. The Taylor family later moved to live in Wootton (Lincolnshire) a nearby village.




