A potition of James Trowell setting forth that he was lately come into this province from South Carolina. He desires 250 acres for cultivation, having a wife and 2 sons. Bouth side great Ogeochee joining the flat ford.

Petition rejected.

March 1765
A potition of James Trowell setting forth that he was removed into this province from South Carolina, having a wife and 2 children, on North side of Ogeochee about 4 miles from flat Ford, and 3 miles from 1

Ludwig Eratz.

Petition granted on his giving security for his good behavior for a year.

Georga, a council in Savannah 3 Dec. 1771.

A petition of James Trowell setting forth that he had been ten years there had a wife and 3 children, for his two sons Joseph and Jonathan. 150 acres in St. Matthew's parish.

Petition granted.

Among others,,, James Trowell of St. Matthews parish, planter, were summons to appear as Potit Jurors at this court, but they failed to appear. It is therefore ordered that they be respectively fined not exceeding 4 pounds.
