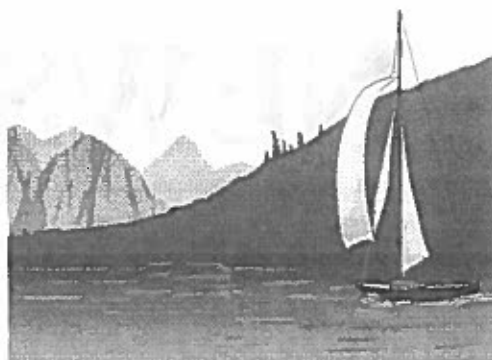

for those who haven't much to go on in searching for their Ludlow ancestry. If you would like to send a listing of similar entries showing your Ludlow or Ludlam/Ludlum ancestors, please feel free to do. Just keep in mind that full pedigrees, family group sheets, descendency charts, etc., are even more desirable for publication.

with your
computer

If you have access to the Internet, research possibilities are virtually endless. I entered the phrase, "Ludlow place names," to see what would come up, and found one search engine would offer anything with the name Ludlow in it, but most of its results were not about place names with the name of Ludlow. That became even more intriguing as I realized it was looking for the word/name Ludlow in any document or presentation. Of course, that means some (perhaps, many) of the sites the search engine came up with weren't very useful, but interesting enough to explore or rule out as soon you came upon a particular site.

One of the first offerings I received from the AOL Netfind was a program titled "Washington Place Names Database" presented by Tacoma Public Library. By reading their response to my search for "Ludlow" and "Port Ludlow," I learned that Port Ludlow, a bay and settlement, was named in honor of Lieutenant Augustus C. Ludlow, an officer on the "Chesapeake," was killed in the War of 1812 during the battle of the "Chesapeake" and the "Shannon" off Salem, Massachusetts in 1813. The Bay was named

Port Ludlow by Commander Charles Wilkes in 1841.

Robert Ludlow Fowler, author of *OUR PREDECESSORS AND THEIR DESCENDANTS*, stated that Augustus was the son of Lieut. Robert Crommelin Ludlow (descendant of Gabriel Ludlow of NYC) and Elizabeth Conkling, and was born 1792 in Orange County, New York.

In the book *SALEM VESSELS AND THEIR VOYAGES* by George G. Putnam, readers will learn that Ludlow's body and Capt. Lawrence's body were moved from Salem, Massachusetts to Trinity Churchyard in New York City on September 3, 1813. The funeral for the two had been previously held at Mr. Spaulding's Meeting House, Salem.

Another site, Trinidad, Colorado: News, informed me of the "Ludlow Tragedy," which was an exchange of fire between striking coal miners and the Colorado National Guard at Ludlow, Colorado in 1914. In that confrontation, 2 dozen people (including miners, wives, children, and guardsmen) were killed.

There are websites on Ludlow, Vermont (perhaps named after Viscount Ludlow); the historic town of Ludlow in Shropshire, England; and an interesting site titled "Attractions in Monroe Wisconsin." Monroe is the county seat of Green County, Wisconsin. Two brief paragraphs on this website pertained to Arabut Ludlow, who was referred to as a "Vermont orphan." Does anyone know his parentage? Arabut had a mansion built about 1857 in Monroe. He was proprietor of a general store, and also the founder of the first bank and community library of Monroe.

I'm going to search in a different way to see what happens. I can type "Place names of Ludlow," or "Places named Ludlow," or a phrase similar to it, and see if different sites pop up.

This Francis (1799-1865), son of Silas Ludlow and Elizabeth Starr, married Rhoda Woodcock, and died in Wapello Township, Louisa County, Iowa. He may have left New York State before 1830. One source stated he was married in Connerville, Fayette County, Indiana. It's also a possibility that this is Francis (Hugh) Ludlow #105 who lived in Cayuga County before moving to Chautauqua County, New York.

Page 11, #105 Francis (H.) Ludlow (1776-1836), son of Silas S. Ludlow?) was known to be in Chautauqua County in 1830 and deceased in 1836. His wife Sally Porter Colton/Coltrin is #181, and still residing in Chautauqua County in 1840.

Page 11, #104 Francis Ludlow may be the same man as #116 who was in NYC in the 1800 census.

Page 12, #111 George Ludlow (1785-1871) is surely the George Ludlow who married Elizabeth Ludlow (1792-1862), dau. of Silas S. Ludlow. They are buried in Ludlowville Cemetery, Tompkins County, New York.

Page 12, #121 Hiran (Hiram) Ludlow is probably the same as #243. He is probably the son of (#189) Stephen Ludlow who had a son named Hiram.
