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**The Family of Patrick O. Linn,
or O'Linn, or Olin, or Olinn, or Linn, or Lynn**

Fourth Generation

57. WILLIAM HENRY LYNN, the son of James and Margaret (Galloway) Linn, was born 12 September 1841 in Barry Co. Missouri.¹ In 1860 William was living with his mother and siblings at Chatham in Sangamon Co.² Just before the start of the Civil War the State of Illinois took a military census of all males between the age of 18 and 45. William was listed in the town of Curran, just north of Chatham where his family was living. He was noted as 21 years old, an American, and a farmer.³

William married 14 Oct 1864 in Scott Co, to Virginia Alice Crum, daughter of Eli and Maggie (Robnet) Crum.⁴ Virginia Alice Crum, called Jennie, was born 20 Feb 1849 in Palmyra IL.⁵ In 1870 William and Jennie were living next door to his brother, Jesse Lynn, near Winchester, Scott Co. IL. Jennie's little sister, Rosa Crum, age 15, was also living with them.⁶

Many years later Nina Hyatt, granddaughter of William and Jennie wrote a short history of her family: "William Lynn was born in Barry Co. MO, Sept 12, 1841 and lived there two years and moved to near Oxville, IL, where he lived practically all the rest of his life. There he married Virginia Crum on October 14, 1864. My mother, Martha Lynn, was born in Sangamon Co. IL August 5, 1868."⁷

William died on 4th November 1892 "at his residence in this county". At the time of his death he owned 120 acres of land in Scott County.⁸ In October 1898 Virginia asked the

court to partition the homestead and set apart her dower.⁹ Virginia wrote her will on 6 April 1898.¹⁰ She died the following year at her home in Scott Co on 31 January 1899 and her son William was appointed the executor on 10 Feb 1899.¹¹ In 1900 William and Virginia's two youngest children were living with their older sister, Arvilla and her husband, Alexander Henson at Naples. Issue:

130. Martha Isabell L. Lynn, b. 5 Aug 1867 at Chatham, Sangamon Co, IL; d. 26 May 1951 at Albia, IA; m. 15 March 1885 in Scott Co, IL, to Andrew Jackson Hyatt, son of Samuel and Sarah (Weaver) Hyatt.¹² At one time they operated the hotel in Naples.¹³ They had four children: Essa; Nina, b. 18 April 1886, Scott Co, m.

Alex Foster [Betty Patton's grandparents]; Ewell Jesse, b. 2 August 1889, m. Elsa M. Parrish; and Lena, b. 9 Aug 1891, m. Abe Crowe.

131. Mary Catherine Lynn, b. 22 April 1871; d. 29 Sept 1924.

132. Levena Stella Lynn, b. 26 Nov 1873; m. Louis F. Roberts 5 May 1897.¹⁴ She had a twin who died at birth.

133. William Orville Lynn, b. 20 Dec 1876; m. Mary Ella Gobble of Pittsfield, IL, on 19 May 1879. They had three children: Lou Jennie Lynn, b. 13 Mar 1898 near Naples, IL, married 19 Nov 1917 Earl C. Painter; Maggie Marie Lynn b. 2 June 1902, married Claude E. Pinkerton on 16 Feb. 1919; Lawrence Lynn b. 3 March 1906 at Foss, OK, died 12 Nov 1933 in Providence, IL.¹⁵

134. Sarah Caroline Lynn, b. 10 Sept 1879. Called Carrie, she married John W. Gobble in Scott Co. on 6 Sept 1899.¹⁶

135. Malinda Arvilla Lynn, born 20 Feb 1882. She married Alexander Henson 7 Mar 1899 and they had six children:¹⁷ Clarence b. near Naples, IL 23 Oct 1900, m. Helen Raider on 27 Oct. 1929; Letha Mildred b. 31 Aug 1902, m. Roy Hinch 5 Oct 1927; Mary Beatrice b. 28 July 1905, m. Russell Tucker, 29 Oct 1923, Hannibal, MO; Florence May b. 2 July 1908 in Pike Co. IL, died 4 May 1933 at St. Mary's Hospital, Quincy, IL; Stella b. 27 Dec 1910 in Pike Co. IL, m. Fred Conkright of Pittsfield, IL on 28 Jan 1933; Eugene b. 29 Oct 1913 in Pike Co, d. May 4th 1933 at St. Mary's Hospital Quincy, IL.

136. Laura Ethel Lynn, b. 26 Sept 1884; m. Harvey Hobson, 8 Oct 1902 at

Winchester IL.¹⁸ They had four children: Minnie b. 1 July 1903, Lloyd Elsworth b. 17 April 1908, Harvey Eldon b. 14 July 1917, Roy Eldred b. 30 Nov 1918.

137. Della Alice Lynn, b. 18 Feb 1887; m. 1st. John Franklin Hobson, 24 Dec 1901, and second a Mr. Lord. Two Hobson children: Orville Franklin b. 2 Dec 1902, and Elmer Floyd b. 17 Aug 1904.

58. JESSE LYNN, son of James and Margaret (Galloway) Linn, was born in October 1843 in Missouri.¹⁹ He married Levenia Caroline Crum, daughter of Eli and Maggie (Robnet) Crum, and sister to Virginia Crum who married William H. Linn, his brother. The license for their marriage was from Macoupin Co. IL.²⁰ Levenia was born 20 November 1847 in Indiana and is listed with her family in 1860 in Macoupin Co. IL.²¹

In 1870 Jesse and his family resided near Winchester, Scott County, Illinois.²² During the 1870's the family moved to Texas where the latter children were born. Levenia died 16 December 1890 in Springtown, Parker Co, TX, and Jesse remarried ca. 1892 to Cordelia, b. July 1850.²³ In 1900 Jesse, listed as a farmer, Cordelia, and his family were living in Roger Mills Co, Oklahoma.²⁴ Issue:²⁵

60. NANCY CATHERINE LINN, daughter of James and Peggy (Galloway) Linn, was born ca. 1847 in MO. Aunt Kate as she was called by some in the family, was probably named after her aunt, Nancy Wilson or her grandmother, Nancy Galloway. She married Leander Cheney 12 December 1866 at Springfield IL.²⁸ He was born 9 August 1839 at Hopkinsville, Christian Co., KY, the son of Joseph Madison and Sally (Corbin) Cheaney.²⁹

One branch of this family reported that Lee was for a time a scout for Kit Carson.³⁰ Lee, as he was called, was in Co. B, 114th Illinois Infantry during the Civil War. He joined at Springfield, IL on 8 August 1862 and was mustered out on 3 August 1865 at Vicksburg, Mississippi. His complexion was dark with blue eyes and black hair. He was 5', 5 3/4" tall. He participated in the long march chasing the Confederate General Price after his last raid into Missouri in the fall of 1864.³¹ Leander's pension listed some of his places of residence: Before the war, Morgan County MO and Sangamon Co. IL; 1865-1867 Chatham, Sangamon Co. IL; 1867-1871 Naples, Scott Co. IL; 1871-1872 Springfield, Green Co. MO; 1872-1873; Grayson Co. TX; 1873-1900 Desidmonia, Eastland Co., TX; 1900-1910 Headrick, Greer/Jackson OK [Jackson County was cut from Greer in 1907]; 1910-1912 Snyder, Kiowa Co. OK.

The family was in Ralls Co. MO in 1870 where Lee is listed on the census as a teamster.³² Perhaps that is why the family could move around so much! In 1880 Leander and Nancy were in Eastland Co. TX with their first six children.³³ Nancy stated that she was 30 years old and b. in MO. Lee Cheany is listed on the 1890 Special Census of Union Veterans and Their Widows, Eastland Co. TX.³⁴

In 1910 Leander and Nancy were living in Jackson Co. OK. She reported that she was 65 years old, b. in IL, and had given birth to 10 children, 8 of whom lived. Living nearby was their son Leonard with his wife Nettie. Also nearby was a Leander C. Cheaney, 26, b. TX and his wife Minnie H.³⁵

Nancy Catherine died at Snyder OK on 10 March 1911. After his wife's death Lee traveled around, noting that in March 1912 he was "visiting at my sons at Bangs, Brown Co., TX". At some point he ended up in Hot Springs Arkansas where he married 2nd. Nancy

Guthrie Conner on 15 August 1913. He died 4 June 1915 at Hot Springs. The undertaker there, T.A. Harris, "prepared the remains" of Leander "for shipment to his former home in the state of Oklahoma."³⁶ Issue of Leander and Nancy Catherine (Linn) Cheney:

150. Charles David Cheney, b. 4 April 1867 in IL; d. 1947; m. Minnie Frances Payne, b. Jan 1873. In 1900 they were living in Eastland Co. TX.³⁷ They lived most of their lives and are buried in Jackson Co., Oklahoma. They had nine children.³⁸
151. Tryphenia Evalin Cheney, b. 20 Aug 1868, IL; m. W. Arch Fulks.³⁹ They had six known children.
152. Sarah Elizabeth Cheney, b. 7 March 1871; d. 1956; m. Rankin R. Browning (1868-1959). They lived and are buried in Eastland Co., TX. Twelve children.
153. Mary Ellen Cheney, b. 11 Nov 1873, TX; d. 1965; m. 1897 Atticus Haygood Jones (1875-1951). They lived in Kiowa Co. OK, buried near Snyder, OK. Six children.
154. Joseph Madison Cheney, b. 9 Dec 1875, TX; d. 1959; m. 1897 Nancy Blackwell (1878-). They are buried in Santa Anna, Coleman Co. TX. Four children.
155. Margaret Ann Cheney, b. 30 Oct 1878, TX; d. 1910; m ca. 1896 James E. White (1870-1912). He was a car dealer in Oklahoma. They are buried in Frederick, OK. Five children.
156. William Marshall Cheney, b. 12 December 1880; d. 1956; m. 1902 Lilly Gertrude Hawkins (1883-1935), buried in Electra, Eastland Co., TX. Seven children.
157. Nathan Corbin Cheney, b. 26 March 1883; d. 1934; m. Minnie Estelle Holly (1888-1975). He was called Dick. They lived and are buried at Electra, Eastland Co. TX.
Two children.
158. Leonard W. Cheney, b. 21 March 1885; d. 1979; m. Nettie Hawkins (1886-1987/8). He was called Jack. They lived in Altus, OK. Two children.
159. Minnie Cheaney, b. 1891, d. the following year.

61. MARGARET A. LINN, daughter of James and Margaret (Galloway) Linn, was born in February of 1852 in MO. Maggie, as she was called, first married to Joseph Tiff on 9 Oct 1868, Pike Co. IL.⁴⁰ In 1870 Joseph and Margaret were living near Pioneer, Greene Co. IL with their daughter Montrith, born in December of 1869.⁴¹ Joseph Tiff must have died as Margaret married 2nd. on 12 February 1885 in Greene County MO to Joseph N. Roby, b. Jan 1857 in Canton, Ohio; d. 6 January 1925 in Clinton, MO.⁴² In 1900 and 1910 Joseph was

listed as a zinc miner in Lawrence Co, Aurora Twp, MO, and in 1920 a blacksmith in Clinton, Henry Co. MO. Joseph Tiff and Margaret had:

160. Monrith Tiff, b. Dec 1869 in Illinois.

Joseph Roby and Maggie had two sons:

161. Charles A. Roby, b. July 1889 in MO; m. Grace W. Simmons. He d. 8 May 1843 and she on 29 April 1949. They are buried in the Englewood Cemetery, Henry Co. MO. They had at least one daughter, Christina.

162. Allen H. Roby, b. June 1893 in MO.⁴³ Allen [Allie] m. Mary E. Price and they had a daughter, Evelyn, b. ca. 1917. Allen d. 18 Sept 1964 and Mary, 7 May 1966. Both are buried at Englewood Cemetery, Henry Co. MO.⁴⁴

63. CHARLES LINN, son of Patrick and Elizabeth (Galloway) Linn, was born 9 July 1843 in MO, and died 13 March 1925 in Summitville, Madison Co. IN.⁴⁵ He m. 1st., 15 April 1864 to Mary Ann Crum, b. 2 April 1840, the daughter of Wm. and Lydia (Coons) Crum, and sister to his brother James' wife.⁴⁶ In 1870 Charles, Mary, and their first four children were living in Greene County, Campbell Twp, MO, with Charles listed as a stone mason. Charles m. 2nd. Martha Jane Etchison, the widow of William Edmond Silvey, with seven children.⁴⁷ They lived in Weiner AR, moved to Oklahoma, and then to Indiana. Charles is remembered by the family as being very patient with his children, stepchildren, and grandchildren. Martha always called him "Mr. Linn as was common in that time period". 167. John Linn, b. January 1870 in Missouri; m. Julie

168. Mary Jane Linn, b. 1872 in Illinois; m. Lewis Kieffer from AR. They had Jacob, Felix, Jessie, George, Bennie.

169. Julia May Linn, b. Sept 1873 in IL; m. Charles Wheaton of AR. They had: Charles, Frank, Iva, Almedia, Julia, Luzilla, Lillie, Harvey.

70. MARY LINN, daughter of Alexander and Anna, was born 1840 - 1844 in Indiana and married James Marion Henson, 26 Dec 1864 Scott County, IL.⁵¹ In 1870 they had two sons, James and Patrick, and by 1880 they had an additional son, Alexander.⁵² At this time they were living near Mary's brother, William and his wife Ellen. In 1900 Marion, as he was called, and Mary were living next door to their son, Alexander and his family. Issue:

 179. Patrick Henson, b. ca. 1873, IL. He had T.B. and was sent to Texas to live with William Marion and Rosa Linn for his health.
 180. Alexander Henson, b. May 1870 IL; m. Arvilla Linn, daughter of William H. and Virginia (Crum) Linn, on 7 March 1899. In 1900 they were living next door to his parents in Scott Co IL. Also living with them were Arvilla's two sisters, Ethel and Della Linn. Alexander and Arvilla had six children: Clarence, Letha Mildred, Mary Beatrice, Florence May, Stella, and Eugene.⁵³

71. WILLIAM MARION LINN, son of Alexander, was born in March of 1845 in Indiana and married 7 March 1867 to Rhoda Ellen Linn in Sangamon Co. IL.⁵⁴ Rhoda, called Rosa or Ellen, was the daughter of James and Margaret (Galloway) Linn and was born in Missouri.

Family history passed down in the family report that Rosa had a brother named Bill and a sister named Maggie Roby. Rosa did very fine handwork. Some of Will Linn's family

was killed in the Civil War. Will was 12 years old at the time of the war. He was too young and his father was too old to fight. They had to hide out from bushwhackers in Missouri. Many years later Rosa Ellen received papers to sign to release her father's property in Missouri which had originally been sold for \$40.00. Rosa refused to sign.⁵⁵

In 1870 William and Ellen were at Naples in Scott County with their first two sons, Alexander and James.⁵⁶ In 1880 the family, still in Scott Co. had grown to five children.⁵⁷ They were living near James and Mary Henson. After 1880 William and Rosa moved to Missouri for a few years, but about 1892 they moved to Desdemona, Texas, in a covered wagon pulled by a pair of droppled gray mares. It took six weeks to make the journey. They arrived at Aunt Kate Cheaney's on Aunt Jennie's first birthday. Aunt Kate and Uncle Lee Cheaney lived at Desdemona, also known as Hog Town. Will had a sister who married a Henson and they had a son, Patrick Henson who had TB and came to Texas to live with Will and Rosa for his health.⁵⁸

The 1910 census of Eastland TX gives us more family data. They lived on a farm, and Ellen reported that she had given birth to 11 children, that nine were living. William and Ellen were both married only once, 47 years ago. Living with them was their daughter, Jennie, and her family.⁵⁹

William died 11 July 1916 in Eastland Co. TX. She died there in 1920. They are buried in the Howard Cemetery at Desidmonia. Issue of William and Ellen (Linn) Linn:⁶⁰

72. JOHN WESLEY LINN, b. ca. 1848 in Illinois, son of Alexander and Anna (Kegley) Linn. He married Sarah Isabelle Crum, 5 Aug 1869 in Scott County.⁶² She was born 1 March 1854 at Palmyra IL, the daughter of Eli and Maggie (Robnet) Crum. She d. 19 Oct 1939 at New Providence IL.⁶³ Although not found on the 1870 census, John was living in Naples, Scott Co. on 7 April 1873 when he signed a receipt for his father's estate.⁶⁴ In 1879 John, as Wesley Lyn, was listed as living in New Providence, Greene Co. IL.⁶⁵ In 1880 John and Anna were living in the Berdan Precinct, Greene Co.⁶⁶ John W. died sometime between 1880 and 23 November 1884 when Sarah married second, in Greene County IL, to James David Pinkerton, son of John and Margaret (McDonald) Pinkerton.⁶⁷ Sarah and James Pinkerton had two children, Edith Muriel, b. 12 Sept, 1889, and Lelia Essie, b. 27 March 1891. Edith married Elmer Ashford of Jacksonville IL on 25 August 1913. Lelia Essie m. 2 Dec 1912 to Richard Moore.⁶⁸

In 1900 Sarah and four of her children were living in the Whitehall Precinct of Greene County. She stated that she had been married 17 years, that she had born six children, and that all were living in 1900.⁶⁹ Sarah died 19 October 1937 and is buried in the Belltown Cemetery, White Hall Township, next to her son, Harry, and daughter Myrtle.⁷⁰ Issue:⁷¹

192. Harry Arthur Linn, b 22 Jan 1875, d. 28 May 1944, buried in the Belltown Cemetery, White Hall Twp.⁷⁴ In June of 1900 Harry was living with his mother, but on 4 August 1900 he married Dora O. Harper in Greene Co. IL.⁷⁵
193. Ada Isabelle Linn, b. 5 August 1877; d. 1948; married Calhoun Co. IL on 4 July 1895 to Edward W. Ballard, 1875 - 1954.⁷⁶ Ada and Edward are buried in the Belltown Cemetery.⁷⁷
194. Flora Myrtle Linn, b. 20 Nov 1879; d. 20 July 1962; m. Homer C. Hiatt on 5 August 1918. He d. 15 March 1956.⁷⁸ They had no children, but brought up a great niece, Louetta Linn Hyatt. Flora Hiatt graduated from the American School of Practipedics, Chicago, and during World War I served as a private secretary in the Government Purchasing Dept. in St. Louis.⁷⁹

75. PATRICK LINN, son of Alexander and Anna Linn, was born 25 November 1855 in Missouri [a twin].⁸⁰ He married Mary P. Session, dau of Joseph and Margaret C. (Thompson) Session, in Scott County, IL, on 8/10 Feb 1881.⁸¹

A book of reminiscences written by John Ellis in 1990 called, "Naples As I Remember" gives some detail about this family.⁸²

"South of Grandma's (Waters) home was the one that belonged to our good neighbors. Jim Sisson lived there with his mother and step-father Martin Snow. Mary, Pearl and Pete were the Sisson kids. Living with the Sissons as neighbors made life a lot of fun. Pete passed away a few years ago. Mary and Pearl live in Jacksonville.

Mr. Sisson's sister, Mary Lynn, lived in the next home with her daughters Margaret, Esta, and Bessie. Mrs. Lynn later was married to Jonah Vaughn. Margaret's early marriage was to Lou Boyd, and she later married Tom (Happy) Mann. Esta's husband was Clarence Hatfield. Bessie's married life was either in Kansas or Missouri. I met her son at Wayne Haley's funeral.

The Lynns supplied us with fresh milk each day and it was my chore to go there to get it each evening. Usually, I had to wait for Mr. Vaughn to milk the cows, but I did not mind since I enjoyed kidding around with the Lynn girls. My thoughts at the time were that Bessie should never have moved away.

The Mary Lynn house had several occupants later. Margaret and Lou Boyd lived there as well as the Nick Hurley family. The Hurley daughters were Golden and Edith. The last occupants were Esta and Clarence Hatfield."

Patrick died on 11 June 1900 and was buried in the Naples Cemetery. After Patrick's death Mary later married Jonah Vaughn, b ca. 1865. Mary died in 1929 and was also buried in the cemetery at Naples.⁸³ Patrick and Mary (Session) Linn had four children:

122. ELIZA ANN WILSON, daughter of Benjamin and Charlotte (Grigsby) Wilson, was born 11 March 1850 in Fulton Co, IL, and died 30 Aug 1921 in Piatt Co. IL. She married Joseph Bennett in Fulton Co. on 25 Feb 1866.⁸⁵ He was born 5 Nov 1839, the son of Abraham and Catherine (Runyon) Bennett.

Joseph was an Elder in the Presbyterian Church at Lewistown, IL. He contracted measles when 50 years old and died as a result. After his death Eliza Ann m. John W. Clark in 1895, Piatt Co. IL.
