Dear Rev. Peeples:

Enclosed is information found on the Alabama families in which you are interested. I did not find the parents of the four persons you were especially interested in. Of course, I did find the information you already have. However, in looking over the enclosed notes, you may get an idea or two to pursue.

If you think the families may have been in Alabama before 1819 (when Alabama became a state, and when the Alabama records start), try the AMERICAN STATE PAPERS. Most large Public Libraries have a set of this publication. The Georgia Historical Society in Savannah has a set. Plan to spend plenty of time to examine, as they are very hard to go through. I would start with the eight volumes on the Public Lands and the one volume on Claims.

Pickett's History of Alabama, published 1878, reprint 1962, lists a Thomas Wiggins as a member of the Convention from the Territory of Alabama in 1819. This Convention was authorized by Congress to form a State Constitution. Thomas Wiggins was a delegate from Monroe County (page 635.) At that time Monroe County covered a large part of Alabama between Conecuh County and Clark County. He could easily be the father of George Washington Wiggins, datewise.

I do hope the enclosed will help. If you have any questions, please let me know.

By bill of exceptions it appears that the deed under which the plaintiff claimed was alleged to have been lost and was not in possession of plaintiff and a witness deposed that he was a subscribing witness to a deed of gift made by defendant to the infant plaintiff in the year 1824 and delivered to him and then placed in the hands of the mother of the infant, who was then a widow, for safe keeping; that she intermarried with the defendant in the year 1834 and that for the greater part of time between 1824 and 1834, she


