Woodson's work, a most remarkable volume, especially for it's time. As one researcher writes, "It is impossible to compile a book of the scope of The Woodsons and their Connections which is inerrant. I do not want to discredit Mr. Woodson in any way; his contribution is extremely valuable to anyone interested in the Woodson family. Those of us who use his book OWE IT TO HIM (my emphasis, ml) to call attention to errors, which were never caused by carelessness, and to supply documented correction". Very well said!

I certainly will appreciate additions and corrections.

NUMBERING SYSTEM

The only thing I am taking directly from "W & C" is the numbering system. It seems that to change it 67 years after the original publication (1915), would be unwise. As the numbers run consecutively and many new identifications have been made, I am adding letters to the known ancestor.

Example: There are no descendents listed in "W & C" for 119 Charles Woodson, so I have added letters where we have been able to add and identify his children. Thus, his daughter Judith Woodson who married

Wm. R. Gilliam becomes 119C. Her children would be 119C + 1, 2, 3, etc. You each have been given a research/subscription number preceded by a W. Those of you who have been able to identify their Woodson connection, have been given the "W & C" number farthest down the line with a Woodson name. This should help identify those researchers most closely connected to you.

Example: 119C/W11 is Camp Gilliam.

We, who descend from the Woodsons are lucky indeed, for we spring from a line that were proud of their heritage and therefore kept records of their families. Dates and places were not always noted and accuracy wasn't of prime importance (at the time), but the nucleus has been recorded and more and more primary records are being found right along.

When one finds a Woodson on their family tree there is little, or no, doubt that the immigrant ancestor is Dr. John Woodson. It has never been proven that he actually was a Dr., but various stories and a strong family tradition say he was. Many published references say: Dr. John Woodson, b.1586, Devonshire, Eng., matriculated at Oxford, 1 March, 1604, age 18, son of Mr. Woodson, gentleman of Bristol. The date and place of his marriage to Sarah Winston has not yet been uncovered, but, on the 29 Jan. 1619, the ship "George" sailed from England and landed in Jamestown, Virginia the following April. Besides the new Governor, Sir George Yeardley, the passenger list recorded (Dr.?) John Woodson, age 33, of Dorsetshire, and his wife Sarah Winston. It has been noted that Sir George Yeardley had recruited new settlers for Virginia, and also that he had enlisted the services of Dr. John Woodson to administer to the needs of his soldiers. Since so many of the early records have been destroyed we are hard put to positively prove much of the tradition. However, bits and pieces are constantly surfacing.

In the interest of space we can only highlight what we know of the first Woodson couple in the new world. Records show them registered in Feb. 1623, along with six negroes, at Fleur de Hundred, near Jamestown, in what is now Prince George County. Their slaves were no doubt part of the very first eleven blacks brought by the Dutch, to Yirginia, in 1619. Most genealogists agree that this is the place where their two sons were born, John about 1632 and Robert about 1634. Again there is no positive proof linking the sons with the parents, but circumstancial evidence and family tradition are strong. One can envision these years as being hard and ever fearful, but perhaps content. Sarah may have lost a child or two, tended a garden and to the household chores, while Dr. John probably took care of the illnesses of the settlement, supervised and helped the negroes with crops, etc. (These negroes were later freed). No doubt they both took a firm hand in raising their sons.

Then came the Indian attack of the 18th of April 1644. As the story goes, Dr. John Woodson was killed within sight of his home. Sarah and a shoemaker, named Ligon, defended the house and killed nine Indians. Sarah received credit for scalding one of them with boiling water and braining another with a roasting spit! At the first sign of trouble she had hidden son John under a tub and son Robert was put into the potato bin, for years to come their descendants were known as "Tub Woodsons" and/or "Potato Hole Woodsons". I have found many people who descend from both brothers. The Woodson gun used by Ligon on this frightful day is now in possession of the Virginia Historical Society.

After this date Sarah seemed to drop from sight. Recently a record was found which gives her possible death date as Jan. 1660. If research proves this to be true, it will be the subject of a future article.

Congratulations and sincere thanks to Marilyn Longobardi and Claudette Maerz. They are taking on a project that has long been overdue! Happy Hunting!....

PROFILE

#1136 Daniel Woodson

From: History of Kansas, by A.T. Andreas, 1883.

Daniel Woodson was editor and half owner of the Lynchburg Daily Republican (a Democratic journal). Seven years later he was appointed by President Franklin Pierce as Secretary of Kansas Territory. At that time Kansas Territory included all lands west of the Missouri, save Texas. The appointment carried a salary of \$2,000 per annum, a large salary in those days. Six times he filled Governor Reeder's chair during those troublous times. Governor Reeder was from Pennsylvania. Woodson helped found the town of Lecompton; for six months the seat of government rotated from Ft. Levanworth to Shawnee Mission, to Pawnee, to Shawnee Mission, and finally to Douglas, soon Thereafter renamed Lecompton, after Cheif Justice Samuel B. Lecompton of Maryland, who had brought the George Armstrong "float". Government was established there in August 1855.

Daniel Woodson owned the northwest quarter of Sec. 10, immediately southwest of the town plat, but moved to town in 1857. After two terms, Daniel Woodson retired as Secretary and was appointed Receiver of Public Moneys for the Delaware District at Kickapoo, Kansas. He farmed at Levanworth, Salt Creek District, for twelve years; in 1870 to Montgomery County, Kansas, helping to establish the first newspaper at Parker, where he was also Deputy Clerk of the County Board and Court. The proposed city was abandoned so he went to Coffeville, Kansas.

Note:

It is stated in his obituary that Daniel Woodson "came to Edinburg, Kansas, Wednesday, October 18, 1854". Edinburg was formerly Shawnee Mission. (Ed.) See Family Group Sheet 1136/

PROFILE

Zachariah & Edwin W. Woodson

Zachariah Woodson came to the area that is now Summers Co., W.Va. in 1832 with his older brother, Edwin W. Woodson, his widowed mother and family. They settled near Forest Hill. Edwin traveled in Monroe, Summers, Raleigh, Giles and Mercer Cos. as a pioneer Baptist minister, organizing churches. Edwin married Adaline Landcraft, and died in 1851. Zachariah later settled on the Greenbrier river where Talcott now stands.
